Podcast March 17, 2026

*“Where are we going up? Our brothers have made our **hearts melt**, saying, ‘The people are greater and taller than we. The cities are great and fortified up to heaven. And besides, we have seen the sons of the Anakim there.’ ‘Then I said to you, **‘Do not be in dread or afraid of them. The Lord your God who goes before you will himself fight for you, just as he did for you in Egypt before your eyes.’**” Deuteronomy 1:28-30*

The enemy's plan is to make us afraid and in dread. This causes our hearts to melt because of past trauma. God's message is different: I will go first and fight for you!

A Covenant of Victory!

*“When you go out to war against your enemies, and see horses and chariots and an army larger than your own, you shall not be afraid of them, for the Lord your **God** is with you, who **brought you up out of the land of Egypt**. And when you draw near to the battle, the priest shall come forward and speak to the people and shall say to them, ‘Hear, O Israel, today you are drawing near for battle against your enemies: **let not your heart faint**. Do not fear or panic or be in dread of them, for the Lord your God is **he who goes with you** to fight for you against your enemies, to **give you the victory**.’” Deuteronomy 20:1-4*

By covenant, the God who set us free (John 8:32) will give us victory!

*“And I sent the hornet before you, which drove them out before you, the two kings of the Amorites; **it was not by your sword or by your bow.** I gave you a land on which you had **not labored** and **cities that you had not built**, and you dwell in them. *“Then the Lord said to him, ‘Know for certain that for four hundred years your descendants will be **strangers** in a country not their own and that they will be enslaved and mistreated there. But I will punish the nation they serve as slaves, and afterward they will come out with great possessions.’” Genesis 15:13*

- ◆ Strangers in Egypt (Genesis 15:13)
- ◆ Little Children of God in the Wilderness (Matthew 18:3)
- ◆ Maturing Stewards of the Promise (remove idolatry in land / hearts)

This is now! We are maturing stewards of the Promise!

We are called to Love God

Podcast May 12, 2026

*“You shall love the Lord your God with **all your heart** and
with **all your soul** and with **all your might**. ”*

Deuteronomy 6:5

Jesus emphasized this in Matthew 22:36-38! This word for all is *kol* (H3605),
a noun masculine, made of *kaf* and *lamed* (11 and 12), which points us towards a
transition to government authority.

When the Bride loves in this way, it transforms and matures us as royal priests.

Love God Exceedingly

Podcast May 12, 2026

- ◆ In Hebrew, Might is *meh'ode* (H3866) an adjective / adverb made from mem, aleph, and dalet. A measurement: exceedingly.
- ◆ All your heart, or *kol lebab* (H3824), a **noun masculine**.
- ◆ All your soul, which is *kol nephesh* (H5315), a **noun feminine**

God created heart and soul to be a completion of our intangible, 'on earth beings!!'

Heart Container

Podcast May 12, 2026

*“My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you, making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding; Then you will understand righteousness and justice and equity, every good path; **for wisdom will come into your heart, and knowledge will be pleasant to your soul.**”*

Proverbs 2:1-2,9-10

The heart is like a container, while the soul (emotions, thoughts of our mind, and choices from our will), is fed by what is in our hearts

Adorned Hearts

The First and Great Commandment

Transformational Intimacy: SEEDS

Podcast June 2, 2026

“Other seeds fell on good soil and produced grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. He who has ears, let him hear.” Matthew 13:8-9

As we are intimate with God each day, the Sower sows seed into our hearts. It is everything that we need for our day, including our irrevocable call (Romans 11:29)

Gather Together with Full Hands

Podcast June 2, 2026

*“They shall **not** appear before the Lord empty-handed.
Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing
of the Lord your God that he has given you.”*

Deuteronomy 16:16b-17

If we are intimate with God each day and receive our seed, and then gather together with full hands, our seeds cross pollinate into a greater measure!!

Fruitful Givers

Podcast June 2, 2026

“You received without paying; give without pay.” Matthew 10:8b

- ◆ We cry out for revival, God's Presence, and Healing
- ◆ All of these come from our collective seeds received when intimate
- ◆ Our fruit has seeds, blown by the Wind* to transform the world!!!

*Ruach (H7307), a noun feminine that means Spirit, Breath, and Wind

Jesus Prayed Alone. A lot.

Podcast June 16, 2026

“But [Jesus] would withdraw to desolate places and pray.”

Luke 5:16

The Fruit: Expressing the Royal Priesthood (forgave and cured paralyzed man)

Jesus Mourned Privately

Podcast June 16, 2026

*“And his [John the baptist] disciples came and took the body and buried it, and they went and told Jesus. Now when Jesus heard this, **he withdrew from there in a boat to a desolate place by himself.** But when the crowds heard it, they followed him on foot from the towns.” Matthew 14:12-13*

When Jesus heard of the death of John the Baptist, He mourned (bakah?) privately.

The Fruit: Right after this Jesus fed 5,000 men, plus women and children

Mountains are Pictures of the Presence

Podcast June 16, 2026

*“Immediately he made the disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. And after he had dismissed the crowds, **he went up on the mountain by himself to pray.** When evening came, **he was there alone**, but the boat by this time was a long way from the land, beaten by the waves, for the wind was against them.” Matthew 14:22-24*

Jesus went up on a mountainside, just like Moses did

The Fruit: Jesus walked on water, calmed the wind, and healed more people!

The Mountain beget The Mount

Podcast June 16, 2026

“In these days he went out to the mountain to pray, and all night he continued in prayer to God. And when day came, he called his disciples and chose from them twelve, whom he named apostles: Simon, whom he named Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James and John, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaios, and Simon who was called the Zealot, and Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot, who became a traitor.” Luke 6:12-16

Jesus received Seeds when He was intimate with God

The Fruit: Jesus knew and chose 12 disciples, and then taught the Sermon on the Mount

As the Father sent Jesus, Jesus sent us (John 20:21)! Let's do greater (John 14:12)!!

Selective Audience of Miracles

Podcast June 23, 2026

*“After this Jesus went about in Galilee. He would not go about in Judea, because the Jews were seeking to kill him. Now the Jews’ Feast of Booths [Sukkot] was at hand. So his brothers said to him, ‘Leave here and go to Judea, that your disciples also may see the works you are doing. For no one works in secret if he seeks to be known openly. If you do these things, show yourself to the world.’ For not even his brothers believed in him. Jesus said to them, ‘My time has not yet come, but your time is always here. The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify about it that its works are evil. You go up to the feast. I am not going up to this feast, for my time has not yet fully come.’ After saying this, he remained in Galilee. But after his brothers had gone up to the feast, then he also went up, **not publicly but in private.**” John 7:1-9 (ESV)*

Jesus did not wait for the **spotlight** before doing the Father’s will

Intent: God's Glory, or mine?

Podcast June 23, 2026

*“About the middle of the feast [Sukkot] Jesus went up into the temple and **began teaching**. The Jews therefore marveled, saying, 'How is it that this man has learning, when he has never studied?' So Jesus answered them, ‘**My teaching is not mine, but his who sent me. If anyone's will is to do God's will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority. The one who speaks on his own authority seeks his own glory; but the one who seeks the glory of him who sent him is true, and in him there is no falsehood.**’ The Pharisees heard the crowd muttering these things about him, and the chief priests and Pharisees **sent** officers to arrest him. So there was a division among the people over him. Some of them wanted to arrest him, but no one laid hands on him. The officers then **came to** the chief priests and Pharisees, who said to them, ‘Why did you not bring him?’ The officers answered, ‘**No one ever spoke like this man!**’” John 7:14-18,32,43-46*

Jesus did not need a stage, but only to follow the Father. The fruit was teaching like no one, ever!

The Prophet

Podcast June 23, 2026

*“When they heard these words, some of the people said, ‘**This really is the Prophet.**’” John 7:40*

*“**I will raise up for them a prophet** like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.” Deuteronomy 18:18*

Some of the people considered His words to be a fulfillment of the prophecy through Moses

Podcast June 23, 2026

This word for **prophet** is *nabiy* (H5030), a noun masculine made from *nun*, *bet*, *yod*, and *aleph*. Its Spirit revealed covenant is

nun *bet*
crowned royal priest whose covenant is to bring

yod *aleph*
[the seeded words of] heaven to earth with intimacy

As the Father sent Jesus...

- ◆ Jesus has sent the Royal Priests to do what He did [John 20:21](#)

The Law of Witnesses

Podcast June 30, 2026

*“A single witness shall not suffice against a person for any crime or for any wrong in connection with any offense that he has committed. **Only on the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses shall a charge be established.***

*If a malicious witness arises to accuse a person of wrongdoing, then **both parties to the dispute shall appear before the Lord, before the priests and the judges who are in office in those days.**” Deuteronomy 19:15-17 (ESV)*

When the people stood far off from the mountain (Exodus 20:18-20), they got rules to follow instead of a relationship that produced the fruit of discernment

Jesus' Two Witnesses

Podcast June 30, 2026

“Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, ‘I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.’ So the Pharisees said to him, ‘You are bearing witness about yourself; your testimony is not true.’ Jesus answered, ‘Even if I do bear witness about myself, my testimony is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going, but you do not know where I come from or where I am going. You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. Yet even if I do judge, my judgment is true, for it is not I alone who judge, but I and the Father who sent me. In your Law it is written that the testimony of two people is true. I am the one who bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me bears witness about me.’”

John 8:12-18

If the Pharisees had known God as Abraham did, Elohim would have counted it to them as righteousness (Genesis 15:6). Instead they were blinded to the Son and the Father.

Jesus' Time

Podcast June 30, 2026

*“Then those who had seized Jesus led him to Caiaphas the high priest, where the scribes and the elders had gathered. And Peter was following him at a distance, as far as the courtyard of the high priest, and going inside he sat with the guards to see the end. **Now the chief priests and the whole council were seeking false testimony against Jesus that they might put him to death, but they found none, though many false witnesses came forward. At last two came forward and said, ‘This man said, ‘I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to rebuild it in three days.’ And the high priest stood up and said, ‘Have you no answer to make? What is it that these men testify against you?’***

But Jesus remained silent.” Matthew 26:57-63b

Jesus was condemned because two witnesses testified that He spoke words that the Pharisees did not understand. They did not have intimacy. Jesus was silent; it was His time.

Podcasts for the month of June 2026

- ◆ Those who are **lead by the Spirit** are not under the Law **Galatians 5:18**
- ◆ Have your own, private, intimate **time** with Yahweh Elohim.
- ◆ If we do not, we will be blind like the Pharisees **Matthew 15:12-14**
